MASKS

- Optional for students, staff, and visitors.
- The District will not tolerate harassment, bullying, and/or disrespect directed toward or about individuals who choose to either not wear a mask, or those who choose to wear a mask in school.
- Students identified as being symptomatic for COVID-19 and/or ill in the school will be asked to wear a mask prior to being picked up by a parent/guardian.
- Masks will be required for COVID-19 positive students, faculty, and staff returning on day 6 through day 10 after isolating/ quarantining for 5 days.

SCREENING

SYMPTOMS

- At Least TWO of the following: fever, chills, shivers, muscle aches, headache, sore throat, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, congestion, runny nose
- At least ONE of the following: cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, loss of taste and smell

QUARANTINE INFORMATION

- Quarantine is no longer recommended for people who are exposed to COVID-19 except in certain high-risk settings.
- Those in schools can continue to attend as long as they remain symptom-free.
